Its population increased from 15000 individuals in 3000 since 1970 but it grevy's zebra lives in savannah of Ethiopia and Kenya.

The skin is **thick** and gray or brown

It can run up to 50 km.

It is a species endangered .

It is chase for its horns.

The department of Africa South environment indicates that in 1004 rhinoceros have been **killed** in the country in 2013 against 668 in 2012 and 13 in 2007.
